Writing Week

All the children from Reception to Year 6 have been involved in different forms of writing based on the curious landing of the canoe. Children have been busy interviewing members of staff to produce police incident reports, newspaper articles and podcasts which we hope will be broadcast by Marlow FM. To help the children understand the different forms of

writing, they had help from the experts – Paul Mansell from Marlow FM came in to work with the Year 3's and give them tips for making a good radio broadcast and the police have been helping the Year 5's write authentic police reports! News reporters from Marlow Free Press also worked with the Year 4 children on their news articles!

We also had a visit from the Poet James Carter who entertained Key Stage 1 and 2 with performances of his poems and Years 1 to 6 had the opportunity to take part in writing workshops with him.

The children looked fabulous dressed up as book characters in final assembly on the Friday. It was particularly rewarding as the children shared some of their work and talked about what they had learnt from the week. It was lovely to hear that a lot of the children felt more confident about their writing and also found that writing can be fun!

We also revealed to the children how the canoe came to be there!

All in all, it was a very exciting and inspiring week with some fantastic writing thrown in for good measure!
