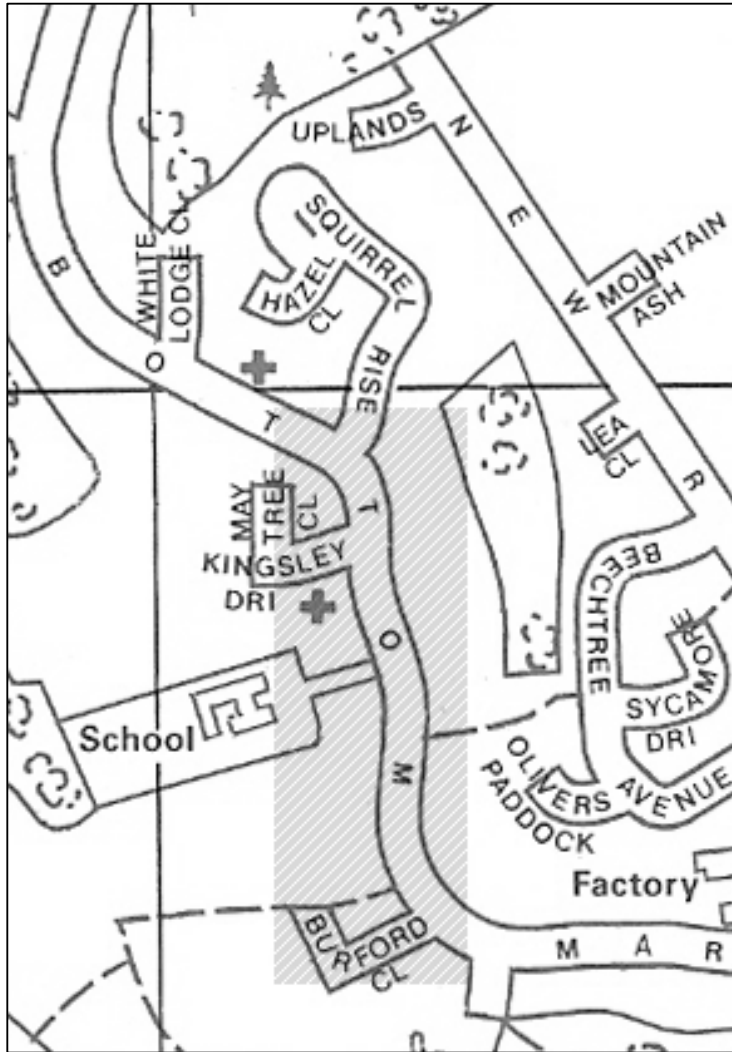
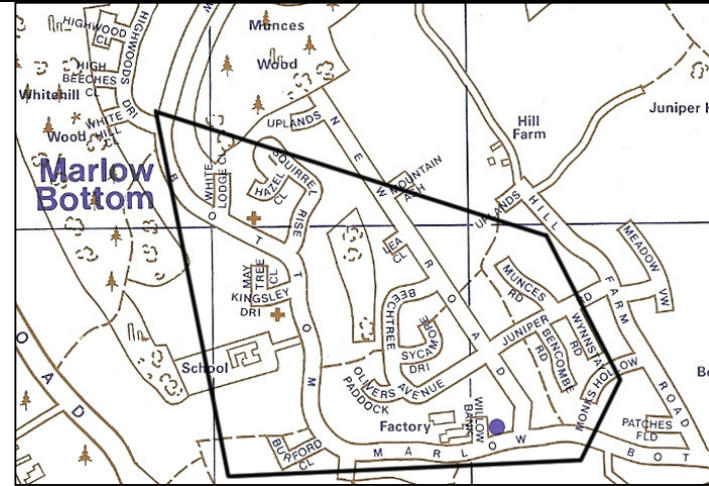


Burford Walk to School Map

MAP A

This map represents the “walk to school” zone. Parents are strongly encouraged to walk to school from the boundaries indicated. If you live within the boundary, then please do your very best to walk from home. Arrangements have been made with T J O’Reilly’s for parents to park in their car park during school drop off and pick up times.

MAP B

This map represents the area of main concern. Between 8:20 - 8:45am and 3:15 - 3:30pm, this area is at its most congested, with the pavements being crowded with walking children and parents.

IF YOU HAVE TO DRIVE TO SCHOOL and park within this area, we would ask that you:

- **Avoid using driveways to turn** - this keeps the pavements safe for walking children/residents.
- **Avoid using Kingsley Drive and Burford Close** – as turning circles, children crossing cannot tell the difference between a car turning to go up the road and one wanting to swing around in a turning circle. Drive on and find a quieter, safer place to turn.
- **Be considerate to local residents** – avoid parking across driveways, on the grass verges and on pavements. Letters have been received by the travel team from local residents complaining about blocked driveways, churned up grass verges and bad visibility.
- **Don’t park on the bends** – particularly Kingsley Drive, Burford Close, Squirrel Rise, this obstructs the drop down pavements designed for use with strollers and wheelchairs and creates bottlenecks where traffic cannot pass safely.
- **Keep zigzag lines clear** – these are designed to enable a clear view up and down the road, especially with the school crossing patrol. DO NOT stop on these lines or park opposite them.
- **Please ensure** children EXIT the vehicle on the pavement side of your car.
