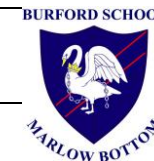


Burford Home–school agreement. Child’s name:

Parents/Carers/Guardians – I/we will:

- Encourage my child to read and hear them read on a regular basis
- Support the school’s policies on behaviour and anti-bullying, including ‘bullying’ on social media sites; and child protection (available on school website)

- Raise concerns with the school in a timely and appropriate manner
