RE: School uniform update, effective from April 2026

With the summer term approaching, and taking on feedback from parents via Parent Forum, I am writing to let you know of one small change to our uniform policy which will come into effect after Easter.

For children in Years 3 and 4, they will no longer have to wear a shirt and tie, instead, they can continue to wear a white polo shirt. For children in Year 5 and 6, they will need to continue to wear a white collared shirt and tie as part of their preparation for secondary school.

Please find below the updated uniform list needed for your children:

Reception & Key Stage 1:	Key Stage 2:
White polo shirt.	Lower KS2, Y3 and Y4: White polo shirt. Upper KS2, Y5 and Y6: White collared shirt (long or short sleeved).
Burford-branded red book bag.	Upper KS2, Y5 and Y6: Burford-branded navy blue and red tie.
Burford-branded red v-necked sweatshirt or cardigan.	
White or grey socks or grey tights.	
Black school shoes.	
Mid to light grey skirt/shorts/skorts/culottes/trousers/pinafore dress.	
In warm weather, a red and white gingham dress may be worn.	

PE Uniform

Burford-branded red PE shirt.

Burford-branded navy-blue tracksuit top (KS1 and KS2 only).

Plain navy-blue shorts/skirt/skort/tracksuit bottoms.

Plain white socks.

Suitable sports trainers/plimsolls with non-marking soles.

In warm weather, a plain red sun hat/cap may be worn.

We appreciate your support in ensuring that the children adhere to these uniform guidelines.

It not only fosters a sense of belonging but also removes any disparities, allowing students to focus solely on their learning and school activities.

Please note that the branded uniform items will continue to be available for purchase from Sports Crest whose details can be found on our school website.
