To support this project, we are asking parents to do the following:

Friday 13th February send in the ingredients for your child's sandwich.

Sandwich ideas must:

- Be healthy
- Include some process of chopping, mixing, grating etc.
- Not need any cooking process at school
- Need limited refrigeration.
- Be achievable independently

Sandwich recipes must not:

- Contain nuts (no peanut butter or Nutella)
- Be unhealthy
- Need warming up/cooking
- Use specialist equipment

If your child would not like to eat their sandwich, please order/send in a pack lunch as normal, and ensure that they have a container to be able to take their sandwich home to show. Enthusiastic volunteers welcome from 11-11:30. Please let your class teacher know if you are able to help.

We hope the children are looking forward to this project.
