Dear Parents and Carers,

Kit List for PGL Liddington

- Children will need comfortable clothing for outdoor activities. Please do not send 'best' clothes as these may get ruined during the activities. Most items will be clothing that children already have so hopefully you won't need to buy anything new.
- ALL clothing and other items (inc. coats) must be named, and children are responsible for their own belongings. We cannot guarantee the safe return of unlabelled items.
- The children will need to transport their own case from the coach park to the accommodation so they must be able to wheel/carry their own luggage. Please carefully consider the size of your child's luggage as there is limited room under the coach. Also, all day bags must fit in the overhead compartments on the coach.
- Items that are not allowed are listed at the end.

What you will need to bring:	
Tops	Long sleeved tops x 2/3 (most of the activities require long sleeved tops to be worn due to harnesses etc.)
Trousers	Long trousers for activities are required (preferably not jeans for daytime as they can get heavy when wet). Trousers may be tracksuit bottoms. Two pairs.
T-shirts	A few t-shirts to go under tops or to wear for an activity that may not require long sleeves (not cropped tops).
Shorts/leggings	Shorts - two pairs of an appropriate length (one pair may get wet). Leggings – one or two pairs for activities or evenings.
Footwear	TWO PAIRS OF TRAINERS – one pair of old trainers which can get wet and one dry pair. NO sandals, flip flops, Crocs, or open-toed sandals. One pair of comfy indoor shoes or robust slippers (if it is wet/muddy then dirty trainers will not be allowed inside).
Waterproof clothing	All children will need a thin anorak / jacket. If the weather forecast is looking very rainy, it may be worth bringing waterproof trousers.
Rucksack	Day rucksack that is not too large and can be easily carried around.
Bin Bag	Labelled bin bag or plastic bag for wet and dirty clothing (this is essential for return travel as we are not allowed to have loose, wet clothes on the coach).
Swimwear	Appropriate swim wear (no bikinis, just swimsuits and swimming shorts). When on water, the children should wear swim wear under a



	t-shirt and leggings/shorts.
Fleeces / Sweatshirts	Warm clothing such as fleeces and/or sweatshirts (in case we are unlucky with the weather or for cold early mornings or evenings - most evening activities take place outside).
Nightwear	Suitable pyjamas
Underwear	Please note that for many activities, socks need to cover ankles so longer socks rather than short sport socks.
Hat	Cap or sunhat for ALL children.
Sun Cream	Children are not allowed to share creams so each child will need their own.
Towels	Two towels: one towel for showering; one towel for water activities. One small turban type towel for hair may also be useful.
Drink bottle	Drink bottle labelled
Wash bag and toiletries	Wash bag (including deodorant, soap, shampoo and toothpaste etc.). Note that children are not allowed spray cans (e.g. spray deodorant, hair spray, body spray etc).
Hair ties	Necessary for daytime activities especially those involving harnesses, and for both boys and girls with long hair.
Sanitary items	We will be taking products for girls, but your child may like to take some items of their own just in case they are needed.
Cuddly toy	ONE SMALL cuddly toy for bedtimes.
Money	£3 to £8 if your child wishes to visit the on-site gift shop.
Not allowed	<p>Please DO NOT pack the following as they are not allowed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Phones • Smartwatches • Electronic items (inc. torches and reading lights as these may disturb other children. No hairdryers/straighteners etc. No handheld electronic games.) • Jewellery • Cameras (inc. disposable ones) • Food of any type • Aerosols / spray cans • Medicines • Valuables of any kind <p>Please note that phones and cameras are not allowed due to child safeguarding measures.</p>
