EYFS Curriculum

At Burford we follow the EYFS curriculum. This consists of 7 different key areas – C & L, PD, PSED, Literacy, Maths, Knowledge and Understanding of the World and Expressive Arts and Design.

We work towards the ELGs for the end of Reception.

On entry, the children will be assessed using our Burford baseline and the government baseline.

P.E.

More details will be given nearer the time.

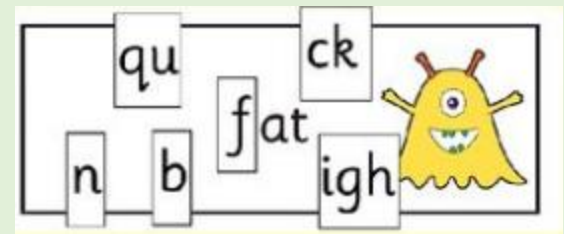


Reading

- Books will be changed weekly. Your child will be given one book at a time. Initially many of the books will be wordless books and when we think your child is ready we will move onto books with words.
- Please read with your child daily for approximately 10 minutes
- Please sign the record book when you have heard your child read and indicate which page your child has read up to or if they have finished the book. Even if your child has read a different book to you, that is not their school book, please sign this in their reading record. This can include non-fiction, newspapers etc.
- A different library book will come home once a week. This is a story book for you to read to your child.

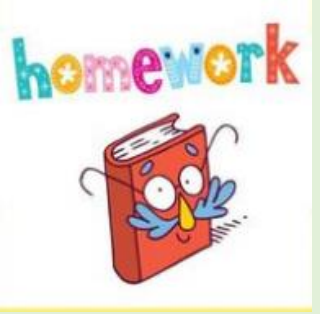
Phonics

- In Reception we teach Phonics every day.
- We use Floppy Phonics, some of your children may already be familiar if they attended our school nursery.
- There will be a phonics meeting for parents after half term. We will confirm the date ASAP.



Tapestry

- All tapestry logins should have been sent to you. Please do speak to your class teacher if you have not received one.
- Tapestry is a great way of sharing what your children have been doing at school with you but also sharing what your children have been doing at home with us. We would really like to be able to share photos with the class of what you have been doing at home. Please could you try to upload 3 tapestry photos every half term. The children are always excited to share these.



Homework

- We ask that all children read to an adult at home every day (for approximately 10 minutes).
- Each Friday (starting from around week 5), all children will have a piece of phonics homework set. We encourage you to complete this with your child. This should be returned by the following Thursday.
