Dear Parents and Carers,

The weather is forecast to be hot next week. With this in mind, we have reviewed our forest school clothing requirements, taking into account the risk of overheating in this very hot weather and balancing it against the risk of scratches and scrapes in the woods. Next week, the children may wear shorts and t-shirts on their Forest School days if parents would prefer them to do so (Monday - Sycamore, Tuesday - Holly, Wednesday -Nursery and Year1). Strappy or cropped tops are not acceptable.

All of the children must wear fully enclosed shoes for Forest School (no flip flops, sandals or crocs) and socks. They must bring a sun hat and a water bottle (we do not have spare water bottles at school). Sun cream should be applied at home before coming to school.

As always, please remember that their clothes and shoes are very likely to get muddy/wet/dirty while the children have a wonderful time playing in the woods.
