Dear Parents and Carers,

We have information to share with you about 3 special summer term events for the children in Reception. Please complete the attached google forms by Friday 22nd May.

Tuesday 5th May – Trip to the Field Studies Council in Amersham

As previously advised, this will take place within the school day. Please can the children wear lightweight long-sleeved tops and trousers (no t-shirts or shorts), along with socks and trainers (no sandals, crocs or flipflops). The children need to bring a small named rucksack containing a **packed lunch (no items containing nuts)** and a **water bottle**. We will be outside for most of the day and so they will also need to bring a waterproof if it's likely to rain, and a cap if it's likely to be sunny. Everything should fit inside their rucksack, which they will carry. If required, sun cream should be applied at home before coming to school.
